The YLD Programme was established to empower young people living with diabetes to champion their cause and represent others living with the condition globally.


Each Programme's cohort runs for three-years and provides its members with online and face-to-face training.

A unique event was held in Indonesia.





# **Exercise Therapy and Diabetes-Related Foot Ulcers**

#### **Special Feature**

Dr. Callum Baker, The University of Sydney, conducts research on exercise training for people with diabetes-related foot ulcers. The benefits of PA are often not realised for people with DFU because of difficulty implementing PA and uncertainty around safety and efficacy. Dr. Baker's research aims to improve the health of people with DFU through clinical trials examining the safety, feasibility and efficacy of exercise.

### His Recent Work with IDF-WPR:

### **Diabetes and Disaster Advocacy Article in British Medical Journal**

**IDF-WPR Chair Elect Alicia Jenkins** and **IDF Chair Elect Peter Schwarz** and colleagues, with discussion with **Prof. Akhtar Hussain** recently published an invited opinion piece regarding the vulnerability of people with insulin treated diabetes during man-made and natural disasters in the British Medical Journal (May 2024).

They discussed the related human rights laws and called for broad advocacy by many organisations and individuals to call for unrestricted access to diabetes care during disasters.

To date the article has been downloaded over 2925 times.


