Boosting the adoption of trustworthy and effective Digital Health Technologies (DHT) across Europe. As part of the project, an innovative assessment framework will be developed that goes beyond existing models, ensuring uniform Health Technology Assessment (HTA) adoption throughout Europe.



Expected impact

- Streamlined health technology assessment procedure for DHT
- Faster adoption of innovative DHT across Europe

DigiCare4You

Reducing the burden of type 2 diabetes and hypertension by firstly, identifying people living with undiagnosed, or at high risk of developing, diabetes and/or hypertension, using schools as an entry point, and secondly, implementing an evidence-based intervention in the community using digital tools.



Expected impact

- More, cost-effective T2D early diagnosis through community-based screening
- Faster adoption of innovative tools
- More responsive, effective, efficient and equitable health systems

Eat Better Live Better

Exploring and promoting the role of plant-based diets in the management of diabetes, through sustainable healthy diets. The project covers activities in France and Portugal, with results being leveraged at European level with the participation of IDF Europe.



Expected impact


- Improved healthy diets for PwD

PRIME

Understanding the multimorbidity of insulin signaling and brain disorders and how these might overlap with somatic conditions.



Expected impact

- Development of better tools for diagnosing, caring for, and preventing insulin-related conditions such as diabetes

Recognised

Studying the biological mechanisms that cause structural and functional alterations in the retina in people with T2D to determine whether these same pathways play a role in the events observed in the brain during the development of cognitive impairment and dementia.



Expected impact


- Increased awareness of cognitive impairment as new comorbidity of T2D
- Provide evidence to reduce progression from mild cognitive impairment to dementia
- Earlier diagnosis of dementia and better planning of future T2D care

ISLET

Building and implementing an innovative programme for the production and marketing of human pluripotent stem cell (hPSC)- derived advanced therapy medicinal products (ATMPs) for the treatment of people living with Type 1 diabetes.

Expected impact

- New scalable sources of islets for transplantation
- Reduced burden and improved quality of life for PwD

Funded by: Horizon 2020

Duration: 2020-2025











Sports & Diabetes: DiaPS

Developing a digital platform for peer support where PwD can share their experience on managing their condition during sport activities.

Expected impact

- Increased participation of PwD in sports
- Improved knowledge of how to manage diabetes during physical activity

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Trials@Home

Exploring the viability of moving conventional clinical trials to a home setting in the form of decentralised clinical trials (DCTs) to streamline data collection, participant recruitment and retention.

Expected impact

- Higher speed, quality, efficacy and reduced costs and clinical trial burden
- Faster development of innovative treatment
- More representative data sets
- PEP Evaluation and PIE guidelines for future projects
