
### A regular quarterly newsletter for the IDF WPR







#### **WPR Congress 2023**

I am proud to report that the IDF-WPR2023/AASD15th has ended with great success.

It gives us great pleasure that the Western Pacific region overcame COVID-19 and united again through this congress. This congress brought together 3518 colleagues\* from 27 countries. We received 522 abstract submissions. 9 outstanding abstracts are awarded as travel grants, and 73 travel support was given to encourage many young researchers to attend the international congress. For seven months since we decided to host the congress in Winter, 2022, we made our best effort to it. I would like to express my deepest gratitude as the host country to my Japanese colleagues in the Organizing Committee for their great support.

Now, the flag of IDF-WPR has been handed over to the next host country, Australia, with our passion. Let us move towards further development of diabetology in Asia and the Western Pacific region and further collaboration among the regions.
